

How to Improve Your Grade in Social Studies

The grades posted both online on ParentVUE and StudentVUE, and sent out in progress reports and report cards, are earned via student performance. My assessments are designed to be a reflection of a student's work and ability. To this end, the assessments may be retaken. To ensure that study and practice has taken place after an initial test, fill out the form below.

Prepare:

1. Review Interactive Notebook (INB), Textbook, or online resources.
2. Use other resources: peer help, classroom INB, siblings, tutors
3. Complete a Great Short Answer summarizing the findings in your study and review.
4. Bring in a Retake Ticket and turn it into the "Retake Basket."
5. Retake test or quiz at the next rescheduled retake opportunity.

Essays and Projects (graded with a rubric):

1. Go over the completed rubric to see where the improvement needs to be made.
2. Add needed elements to the existing project, or re-write on new paper for essays.
3. Double check new work against the rubric.
4. Attach a new rubric to improved/new work.
5. Turn in corrected/updated work into the "Retake Basket."
