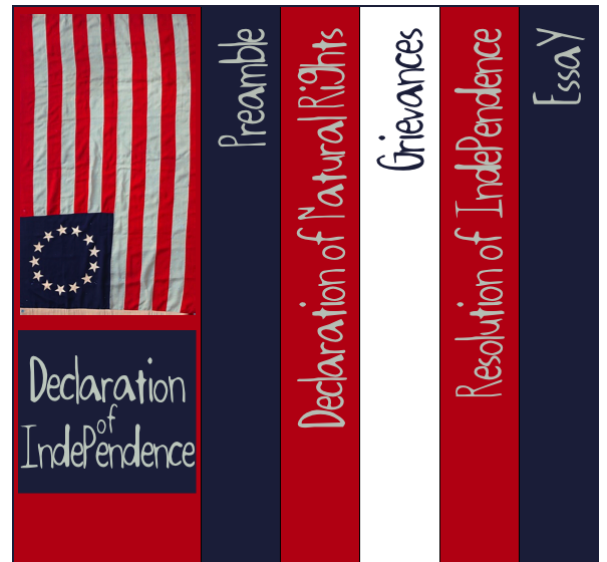


Declaration of Independence Flip Chart
