BAND GRADING

(Standards-Based Assessment)

- Performing on instruments, alone and with others, a varied repertoire of music.

Practice Sheets (Handed out every 6 weeks (also on website); Goal of 2 hours/week.

Playing Tests (Students can opt to play tests in class OR send in audio/video recording OR play test right after school).

Concerts (These count as group-exams...attendance is required, please communicate scheduling conflicts ahead of time and illness/emergency/etc. so that grade is not affected.

- Improvising melodies, variations, and accompaniments.
- Reading and notating music.

Students will complete music theory lessons together in class; Theory tests will be given every 6 weeks;

Students will complete rhythm-reading lessons together; Short rhythm-counting tests will take place periodically.

- Listening to, analyzing, and describing music.
- Evaluating music and music performances.

Students will use state adjudication sheets to evaluate their own and others' performances, using in-class recording equipment and live festival performances.

INSTRUMENT RENTAL & PURCHASE

All **7th/8th grade students** are encouraged to rent/buy (or rent to own) an instrument from a music store** (Our limited number of school instruments will be primarily used by beginning band students - if there are any remaining - once 6th graders have theirs, they will be made available to 7th/8th graders.)

6th grade beginning band students can either rent/buy (rent to own) from a music store** OR rent an instrument from Ogden on a first come, first serve basis.

Music Store Rental Night at Ogden:

Ogden will host a rental night (Ogden cafeteria) on **Friday, Sept. 15** for all interested parents. Parents will be able to rent/buy instruments and accessories at that time. Rental night flyers will be sent home with more info.

(This is an opportunity to rent/rent-to-own or purchase instruments from a music store. Ogden-owned instruments will not be rented out at this event - that can be taken care of using the Ogden instrument rental form (and those instruments will be issued out in band class)).

**Advantages of renting/buying from a music store: by renting an instrument from a music store, the student is guaranteed to play their instrument of choice; instruments are typically in superb condition; maintenance can come at little to no cost (depending on the store).

School Instruments:

Ogden also has a limited number of school instruments that can be rented for the year for \$50 on a first come, first serve basis. The week of Sept. 19, school instruments will be **assigned** to students who have turned in completed forms/payment - in the order that the forms were turned in.

School Instruments:

Ogden has a limited (5-6 of each type) number of school instruments that can be rented (primarily by 6th grade students) for the entire school year for \$50.

6th GRADE INSTRUMENT OPTIONS

BEGINNING BAND STUDENTS CAN OPT TO PLAY THE FOLLOWING INSTRUMENTS (see notes*):

Flute
Clarinet
Alto Sax
Trumpet
Trombone
Baritone
Percussion*

**(You will need to buy bell mallets and drum sticks. You will eventually play a variety of percussion instruments in class)*

Electric Bass*

**(You will need to buy a bass guitar (Guitar Center is a good option...Ogden/music stores do not rent these out), soft case, and a small amp to bring to band)*

Keyboard*

**(Only students who have taken piano lessons will be considered...there is only one keyboard)*

No Guitar*

(Guitars will not be an option for 6th grade; In 7th/8th Grade, students must pass an audition)

BAND SUPPLIES

- 3-ring binder
- plastic sheet covers (25)

- Combination Lock (7th/8th Grade Only)

**for assigned band locker - please no 'key' locks...students tend to lose the keys, and then we have to break off the lock. I will keep combinations on file in case students forget combination. Flute/Clarinet players can opt to store their instruments in their regular school lockers instead.*

(Local music stores keep these in stock, including Wally's Music in Oregon City, Joyful Noise Music, Beaverton Music and Beacock Music. It is always best to call ahead and make sure they haven't run out - and they will always order more)

- Instrument Care Kits

Specific to each instrument, these contain supplies needed to properly maintain and care for the instruments (valve/slide oil, slide/cork grease, cleaning cloths/swabs, etc.)

(Wally's Music, Beacock Music, Guitar Center, other music stores keep these care kits in stock - \$15-\$25)

INSTRUMENT-SPECIFIC SUPPLIES:

- Clarinets and Saxes: Always have at least 4-5 reeds in your case. (You can buy them by the box from music stores (Sizes - 6th grade: #2, 7th: #2/#3; 8th: #3)
- 6th Grade Percussion: Bell Mallets, Drum Sticks
- 7th/8th Grade Percussion: Drum Sticks
- 6th Grade Electric Bass: You will need to bring your own amp to band.

Reminder: Concerts are considered group-exams. Attendance is required, so please communicate scheduling conflicts prior to the event and illness/emergency/etc. in a timely manner so band grade is not affected.

Field Trips: Ogden's field trip policy states that a student must be passing all classes (no F's) to participate in field trips that take place during the school day. Field trips and events outside of the school day are not affected by this policy, and band students can participate in these events. Example: Jr. Rose Parade takes place in June during the day, so students must be passing all their classes; Winter Concert takes place in the evening, so all band students can participate.
