Paper Orientation is



To Make the Grid and Outline the Map (40):

1. From the top of the paper, measure down 1" and make a mark. From the mark, measure and mark every 4" (marks at 1", 5", 9", and 13"). Repeat on the other side of the paper. Connect the marks to draw 4 horizontal lines.
2. From the top line, label 70 N, 60 N, 50 N, and 40 N. The bottom edge of the paper is 30 N.
3. Along the 70 N line, measure and mark every 1 1/2", beginning 1" from the left edge. You will have 7 marks.
4. Along the 40 N line, measure and mark every 1 3/4", beginning 1/4" from the left edge. You will have 7 marks.
5. Connect the marks to draw 7 slanted, vertical lines.
6. From the left, label 20 W, 10 W, 0, 10 E, 20 E, 30 E, and 40 E.
7. Draw in all the land that appears in the grid (even if it isn't part of Europe).
