<b>9</b>	<p><b>Awesome</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Notebook contents are complete. <b>8</b>	<p><b>Pretty Darn Good</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Your notebook has about 90% of the components expected, including page numbers and titles.</li> <li>✓ Information on the right-side and left-side topics is mostly correct.</li> <li>✓ Notes include the majority of the information but may be incomplete in some areas.</li> <li>✓ Processing assignments are incomplete or lack either color or effective diagrams.</li> <li>✓ Displays general understanding of the content material.</li> <li>✓ Shows reflection on the work done.</li> </ul>
<b>7</b>	<p><b>Kick it up a Notch</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Your notebook has about 80% of the components, including page numbers and titles.</li> <li>✓ Notes do not include all of the necessary information.</li> <li>✓ Information on the right-side and left-side topics is partially correct.</li> <li>✓ Processing assignments show minimal processing of information.</li> <li>✓ Displays limited understanding of the content materials.</li> <li>✓ Shows little reflection about the work done</li> </ul>
<b>6</b>	<p><b>Better Get Moving!</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Your notebook has less than 70% of the components expected, including page numbers and titles.</li> <li>✓ Notes are incomplete or incorrect.</li> <li>✓ Information on the right-side and left-side topics is incomplete.</li> <li>✓ Processing assignments are incomplete or missing.</li> </ul>
<b>5</b>	<p><b>What Happened?</b></p> <p>You turned in a notebook, but many of the pages are blank or only include the class template.</p>
