## **Survivor Nyos**

Interview of a young female (16-25 years old) who was at Nyos the night of August 21, 1986. She describes the sensations she felt as the CO<sub>2</sub> cloud swept through the village of Nyos.

You were at Nyos the night of August 21, 1986?

Yes.

Did you pass-out?

Only one day.

Did you wake up the next morning?

Yes.

How many people died in your house?

Three

So, three people died in your house?

• No, four people died.

• No, there were three of us that lived.

So, three people lived?

Yes.

What did you do when you woke up the next morning?

• What?

When you woke up the next morning, did you walk around?

Yes.

Were you afraid? Hey, where are you going? Come back here. We will only talk a little bit more. Did you feel something burn your skin that night?

• Yes, my skin was hot.

Your skin was hot; did you remove your clothes?

• I don't know.

You don't know, but you felt something hot?

Yes.

For that night?

Yes.

When you woke up the next morning was your skin still hot?

• No.

Your skin was not sore the next day?

• No.

Did you vomit?

• No.

When you felt your skin get hot did it happen quick?

• Only my eyes rotated.

What?

My eyes rotated.

When your eyes turned, did you feel heat?

• Yes.

How hot was it? Was it hot like a fire?

• No.

How hot was it?

• I don't know.

Was the heat similar to a sunny day?

• Yes.

So, it felt like the sun was shining?

• Yes.

It was not hot like a fire?

No.

Did you feel heat the next morning when you woke up?

No.

So, you had no problems the next day? What did you see that night?

• I saw a light like the moon was shining.

It was light like the moon was shining?

Yes.
